Academy of Holy Angels (AHA) is a coeducational Catholic high school located in Richfield, MN. Richfield is an inner-ring suburb of Minneapolis with a population of approximately 37,000 people. Holy Angels draws students from 101 parochial and public grade schools and junior high schools across the Twin Cities metropolitan area. Holy Angels serves 620 students from diverse ethnic backgrounds. In 2022-23, our student body included:

The Sisters of St. Joseph of Carondelet established Holy Angels as a girls school in 1877. It became a coeducational high school in 1972.

A Note About our Programs

AHA COVID RESPONSE

The 2020-21 school year was in-person all year with a variety of learning plans. The school year began with a hybrid, block plan and moved to a hybrid, 7 period day plan in early February.

Trimester three began with two weeks of in-school hybrid learning before moving to full in-person attendance with a 7 period day through the rest of the school year. Some students chose to be fully on-line for a portion or all the 2020-21 school year due to personal or family health concerns and students were able to be in class via online instruction. There was scattered asynchronous instruction for independent work and tutorials throughout the year on Wednesdays.

There was no reduction in grading standards or expectations. AHA was open for fully in-person instruction for the 2021-22 school year.

Writing Across the Curriculum

AHA's Writing Across the Curriculum (WAC) program ensures that students develop many kinds of writing skills, and every class at AHA has a writing component. Each student maintains a writing portfolio for four years, and a complete writing portfolio is a graduation requirement.

STARS Service Requirement

All students must complete 75 hours of service to graduate: 15 hours for ninth graders and 20 hours per year for tenth, eleventh and twelfth graders. AHA students completed 23,067 hours of service during the 2022-23 school year.

STEM Diploma

AHA students can earn a STEM Diploma by enrolling in rigorous science and math courses, participating in related co-curriculars, and engaging in job shadow and internship experiences. Thirty-seven members of the class of 2023 earned STEM diplomas.

Theater School

AHA's Theater School is a four-year academic program embedded in the general curriculum. It is designed so that students can fulfill their graduation requirements while focusing their elective credits in the theater curriculum. AHA's theater curriculum includes both technical and acting program tracks. Four members of the Class of 2023 earned Theater diplomas.

World Language Seal

AHA and the MN Department of Education recognize the superior efforts of students who achieve bilingual or multilingual proficiency before graduation. These students have demonstrated language abilities in a second language according to national language standards and state approved testing protocols. They can earn a special designation on their diploma based on their level of achievement: Platinum, Gold or Proficiency. Sixteen members of the Class of 2023 were recognized with this achievement.



Admission to AP classes is not restricted. In the 2022-23 school year, 17 AP classes were offered and 282 students completed 570 Advanced Placement Examinations. Of the 570 exams taken, 66% received scores of 3 or higher. 78 were AP Scholars of some level and the average score was 3.59.


